Manuscripts should be sent/submitted in the electronic form to the e-mail address:

Along with the paper, additional data should be submitted:

- Paper written in the native language (Bosnian / Croatian / Serbian / Montenegrin) and translation in the English language
- Author's name and surname
- Institution name (if exists)
- Author's address and e-mail address
- Title, abstract (no more than 250 words), and keywords (three to five) in Bosnian / Croatian / Serbian / Montenegrin and English language
- References
- Short biography

The languages of the journal are Bosnian / Croatian / Serbian / Montenegrin and English, in Latin script (Times New Roman, 12pt, single-spaced). Journal is published bilingually.

The authors are responsible for the copyright of the submitted materials. Authors whose papers are accepted, sign a statement that they are familiar with the instructions for authors and the obligations of the authors defined in the Editorial Policy of the journal, as well as the agreement on the transfer of copyright to the publisher of the journal Bosniaca. NULBIH will also publish the accepted papers in electronic form, and has the right to use abstracts or parts of the submitted papers.

Editorial Board of Bosniaca will inform the author if the text is accepted within a maximum of two months of receipt of the paper, but reserves the discretion to evaluate the works and not to publish them if it finds that they do not meet the content and formal criteria.

Model of citation “In-text-citation” is used in the texts, as a guidance method of the first element, date, and page.

At the end of the paper, cite references alphabetically by author's last name using the syntax of *APA Style (APA 7)*.
